

# Washington Academy of Barbering & Arts Facilities Disclosure Statement\*\*

## Purpose

This disclosure is provided to ensure transparency regarding all facilities utilized by Washington Academy of Barbering & Arts for the delivery of its barbering program. In accordance with accreditation standards, this document identifies each location where any portion of the program may be taught and describes the purpose and use of each facility.

### I. Primary Instructional Facility

The primary facility is the main campus where the majority of instructional and practical training occurs.

#### Services Provided at Primary Facility:

Practical training on mannequins and live clients  
Student clinic floor services  
Administrative offices  
Student support services

This facility is equipped with barbering stations, instructional classrooms, and all necessary equipment required to meet state board training standards.

### II. Additional Instructional or Training Facilities (If Applicable)

#### A. Temporary or Event-Based Training Locations
